



Winnsboro Animal Shelter Pet License Information

Pet licenses are required in the City of Winnsboro limits for all dogs and cats over 4 months of age. A city of Winnsboro pet license is valid from the date of the rabies vaccination through the expiration date.

How do I obtain a pet License?

- 1) Stop by the Winnsboro Animal Shelter with your pets Rabies vaccination certificate (one per pet). One of our Animal Control Officers will approve your vaccination certificate.

- 2) Take your approved Rabies vaccination certificate to Winnsboro City Hall along with \$5.00 fee per pet. A Texas-shaped pet license will be assigned to you for each pet.

Why license your pet?

- It is required by City of Winnsboro code of ordinances Sec. 2.01.010 and Sec. 2.03.001.
- Protection for our community's health and safety by protecting your pets and helping control the potential spread of rabies.
- If your pet ever gets lost and/or picked up by the Winnsboro Animal Shelter, we will know how to contact you.
- Pet licensing helps the city maintain current data on the identification and number of pets in the City of Winnsboro.

Reminders:

- The pet license expires the same date that the Rabies vaccination certificate expires.
- The owner of dog/cat can replace lost tags through City Hall with current pet license and \$5.00 fee.
- If there is a change in ownership of the licensed pet, the new owner (if a city resident) shall have the pet license changed to his/her name. There is no charge if the pet license has not expired.
